



WILLMAR FESTS PARADE RULES

1. All items **MUST** be **handed** out from the sidelines!
2. No “throw outs” **OF ANY KIND** are allowed from any vehicle or float. Water guns and squirt guns will not be allowed on any unit. The only exception to this rule is T-shirts in which you must make sure they are thrown to the curb.
3. If your unit is caught throwing anything(except T-shirts) from either your float or vehicle you will be pulled out of the parade at the next intersection. **THIS IS YOUR WARNING.**
4. All units must be in position (1) one hour before the parade starts. Parade starts promptly at 10:30 a.m.
5. All vehicles not needed in the parade are to be kept off the line up route.
6. Each performer or unit shall be responsible for his own equipment, props, costumes, signs, and mode of transportation in the parade unless prior arrangements have been made with Willmar Fests.
7. All Animal units **MUST** provide their own clean up.
8. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on any unit. If any driver of a unit permits this, they will be ticketed under the Open Container Law. There will be no warning.
9. All parade units must have eye appeal, be entertaining and be professionally made in appearance.
